Under the direction of the Case Manager the Mobile Crisis Response Team Worker is responsible for supporting both the Neyaashiinigiing Police and Nawash Health and Wellness Department; by responding with uniform officers to assist with de-escalation, community referrals, diversion, and appropriate facilitation to acute care where required to help ensure positive outcomes for the individual. Worker will also act as a resource to officers as necessary.

- Master's Degree in Nursing, Psychology or a related health or Social Services field with three (3) years' experience working in the community with individuals with significant mental health needs and substance use disorders **OR**
- Bachelor's Degree in Nursing, Psychology or a related health or Social Services field with five (5) years' experience working in the community with individuals with significant mental health needs and substance use disorders
- Experience in law enforcement/corrections is an asset

- Knowledge of a range of crisis prevention and intervention approaches and strategies
