### **Position Summary**

Child Welfare Prevention Worker will work collaboratively with the on-reserve band representative and be responsible for representing and advocating for the children and youth of Munsee-Delaware Nation who are and/or at risk of involvement with the child welfare system. The Child Welfare Prevention worker will focus on delivering programs and services to assist families access prevention supports. This is a leadership role and requires full commitment, which may include being available outside ordinary business hours of work, including evenings, and weekends, and maintaining office hours

### **Key Responsibilities**

- Provide prevention support services to Munsee-Delaware Nation members that are involved or may become involved with CFS such as family therapy, children and Family support programs
- Responsible for assisting in the development of and maintenance of children and youth related activities, documentation, and files
- Ensuring that child welfare agencies address culture, land, and family needs of Munsee Delaware Nation children and youth involved in the child welfare system
- Collaborate with the Band Rep to participate in all service plans, plans of care or service development for Munsee-Delaware Nation members.
- Prepare reports and presentations on prevention services for the Child and Family Services Coordinator and Chief and Council as needed.
